

B + C



↓ Wind




A is approaching on ?-tack, B on ?-tack, B on cross ahead of B so hails, "Hold your course!" B makes no response, but adjusts course at 2 and protests under rule 10. No contact occurs. Should the protest be upheld?


For each pair (A+B, B+C, A+C), are the boats overlapped? If not, which is clear ahead?

Is A the leeward or windward boat (relative to B)? Is C to leeward or windward of D?


5] ↓ wind



Three club Racers are sailing downwind. A has her pole extended and is flying her genacker. B started to set her kite after rounding the last mark, but changed plans. However, her bowsprit is out. C's bowsprit is in the standard junior position.


- Are A and B overlapped? Which is the windward boat?
- Are B and C overlapped? Which must keep clear?

A and B are approaching on opposite tracks. At 1, B tells A that she will be tacking, then does so. A tries to duck B, but her hull collides with B's rudder at 2. A protests, saying that B was tacking and therefore had to keep clear by rule 14. Is A correct?



A is overtaking B. Just before 2, A established overlap and at 2 she yells to B, "Overlap, keep clear!" At 3, she strikes B's boom with her shroud.

- At 1, who has right of way?
- After 3, which boat(s) should be penalized? why? As a protest committee, would you need more information?



↓ wind

At 1, A and B have been overlapped for some time. Rule 17 is not applicable. A begins to luff B up, but strikes B's stern at 3. Who should be penalized? Under what rule?



↓ wind

At 1, B and C are overtaking A. B is limited by Rule 17. At 2, A begins luffing up. B avoids A but collides with C at 3.

- Has A violated a rule?
- Has B violated a rule?
- Has C violated a rule?
- Is any boat exonerated by 64.1(c)?
